Objectives

To contribute to the maintenance of economic activity during the COVID-19 health crisis.

To support the professionals of the sea, the restaurant owners and the personnel particularly mobilized within the framework of the sanitary crisis (nurses, police stations).

To promote the traditional professions.



Aquasolidaire

Actions

Mobilization of fishermen and fish farmers of the Var and Alpes-Maritimes from April to June in order to supply the territory of the GALPA Estérel Côte d'Azur with fresh fish.

Provision of coolers / isothermal bags for the fishermen who were partners in the partners of the project. Putting in touch the professionals of the sea and the restaurant partners of the project in charge of cooking the fish and to elaborate the dishes.

Organization of the delivery of meals to to several trades particularly mobilized during the health crisis (medical staff, policemen) and to the most needy by the the Saint-Vincent de Paul association.

Maintaining the activity of fishermen, fish farmers, fishmongers and restaurant owners.

Strengthening of the links between the the different trades involved in the project.
