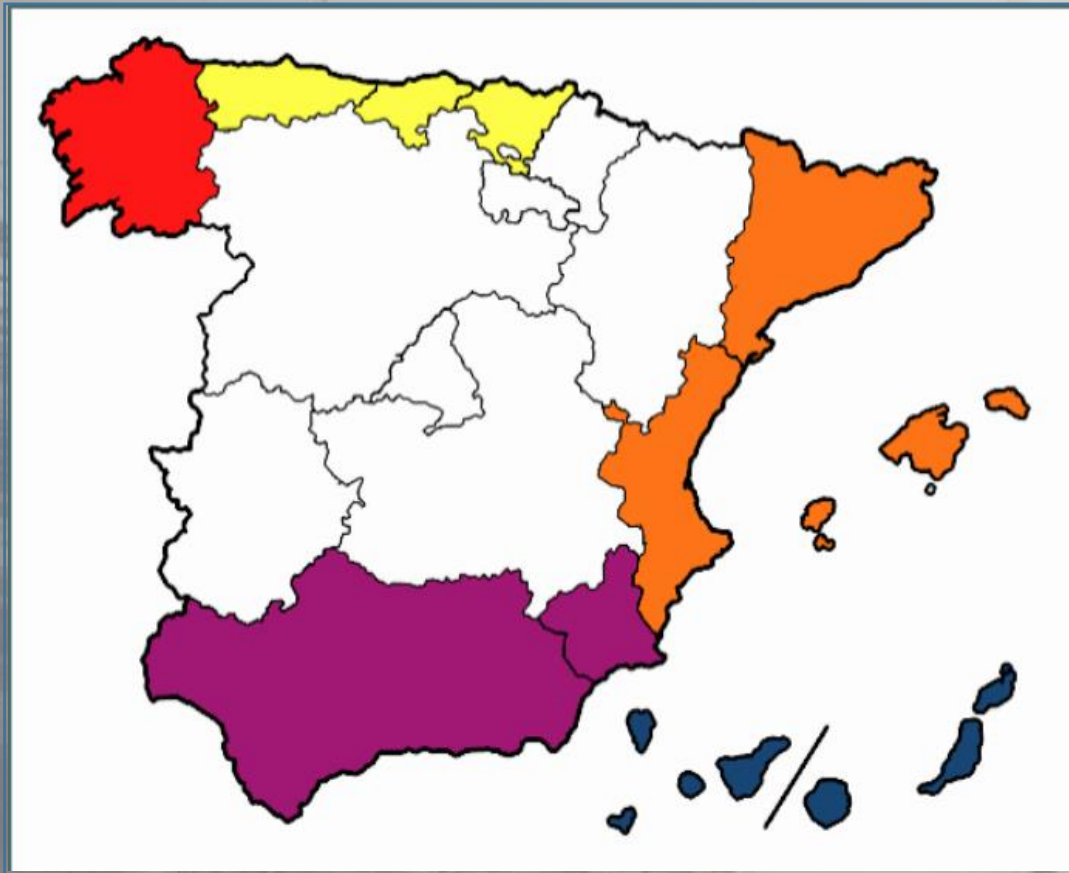
What for?

- Ownership of the CLLD process
- Bottom-up approach
- Richness of opinions, in special from the CLLD practitioners
- Discussion forum amongst IMO's and FLAG's
- Promoting co-operation and co-responsability

How are we performing the process?

- Virtually, due to the health situation & written consultations
- Limitations of videoconference system in participation
 - Sessions of no more than 15 people
 - Different for IMO's and FLAG's (freedom to speak)
 - Geographically grouped for situation equality

First round: Meetings: January 25th – 29th
EFMAP Priority 3 improvement

- I. IMOs (10 partners)
- II. Cantábrico (Biscay Gulf) (10 FLAGS)
- III. Galicia (8 FLAGS)
- IV. Canary Islands (7 FLAGS)
- V. Southern Mediterranean Sea (8 FLAGS)
- VI. Northern Mediterranean Sea (8 FLAGS)

Details of CLLD functioning for OP

Which are the main CLLD objectives ?

- Socio-economical progress of fishing & aquaculture dependant communities
 - Economic growth
 - Social inclusion
 - Employment and labour mobility
- Diversification of activities.

- Improvement of the whole management system
 - More competences on FLAGs → MORE TRAINING
 - Less administrative burden → MORE ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT
 - Better financial framework → PUBLIC ENDORSEMENTS SYSTEM

- Consultation on the whole operative programme (Written Cons.)
- Consultation on result indicators (Probably meetings)

- Preparation of CLLD strategies
- Selection of FLAGs and Strategies approval (once O.P is approved)
