EMFF: Art. 63.1: **5 objectives**/types of projects:

- adding value
- diversification
- environment
- socio-cultural
- governance

Art. 63.2:

Support "may include measures provided for in Chapters I, II and IV", and then the **relevant conditions** and the scales of contribution per operation (...) **shall apply**

2021-2027

Draft EMFAF:

Art. 26: Ensure that communities (...) better exploit (...) opportunities offered by the **sustainable blue economy**, capitalising on and strengthening environmental, cultural, social and human resources Can focus on **fisheries/aquaculture** or **broader diversification**

No equivalent provision / requirement

- all sectoral and cross-sectoral economic activities
- relating to oceans, seas, coasts and inland waters
- emerging sectors and non-market goods and services,
- environmental, social and economic sustainability

(F)LAG tasks

 CPR: LAG tasks shall include: build capacity of local actors draw up selection procedure and criteria ensure projects' coherence with LDS prepare and publish calls receive applications select operations and fix amount of support monitor implementation and carry out evaluation 	
Exception : for cooperation projects selection could be done by the MA	



(F)LAG tasks

2014-2020

2021-2027

CPR:

LAG tasks shall include:

- build capacity of local actors
- draw up selection procedure and criteria
- ensure projects' coherence with LDS
- prepare and publish calls
- receive applications
- select operations and fix amount of support
- monitor implementation and carry out evaluation

Exception: for cooperation projects selection could be done by the MA

Draft CPR:

LAGs shall **exclusively** carry out **all** of the following tasks:

- <u>build capacity</u> of local actors
- draw up <u>selection procedure and</u> <u>criteria</u>
- prepare and publish calls
- <u>select operations</u> and <u>fix amount</u> of support
- <u>monitor</u> implementation
- carry out <u>evaluation</u>

No exception for cooperation projects envisaged: *so selected by the FLAGs*

Possibility of higher aid intensity under CLLD (up to 100%)	
Specific provisions for advance payments (EMFF Art. 62)	



Financing arrangements

EMFF can finance up to 85% of total public contribution if the whole axis implemented by CLLD (10% more than other UPs, Art. 94)	<u>Standard MAXIMUM</u> co-financing rate of 70% for the whole EMFAF
Possibility of higher aid intensity under CLLD (up to 100%)	Possibility of higher aid intensity under CLLD (up to 100%)
Specific provisions for advance payments (EMFF Art. 62)	No explicit provisions for advance payments under CLLD

(Art. 26) MAs shall complete the first round of selection of strategies and ensure the local action groups selected can fulfil their tasks () within 12 months of the date of the approval of the relevant programme (or last programme concerned, in case of multi-funding)

Possibility of one Fund (" lead Fund ") covering preparatory support and running and animation costs	



Multi-funding
