# Why start a common project

### Why


- Large problems from seal and cormorants
- No understanding for the situation

#### What

- Scientic interview of 220 fishermen in 6 countries
- Inform about the results








Interview 220 fishermen in 6 countries

The gravity of seal and cormorant induced impacts to interviewee's fishing livelihood in study areas

Indexes show how serious the impacts were assessed by the fishers



The average seal and cormorant induced losses estimated by the fishermen

FINLAND
Seal 19 930 € (n= 77)
Cormorant 5 993 € (n= 52)

SWEDEN
Seal 22 064 € (n=67)
Cormorant 5 667 € (n=42)

## Benefits of cooperation

- More attention, better understanding and acceptance
- Baltic Sea is a homogenous area, need of cooperation
- Learn and spread know-how
- Influence on national- and EU-meetings

### **Problems**

- Seals and cormorant are sensitive subjects
