- CY: 1 diving network with GR (preliminary)
- HR: 1 MPA working group (Med)
- DK: 1 cultural & nature tourism w/ SE
- **EE: 34** (92 reported), joint marketing, festivals, youth events, study trips...
- FI: 5 seals & cormorants, fishing technique transfer, study trips
- FR: 8 (+7 under development), promotion of local products, improving aquaculture techniques, fish stock management and waste management.
- **DE: 1** promoting area as a (fisheries) culinary address
- GR: 15 (preliminary stage) diving network, pesca-tourism, working group on MPAs, wetland life...

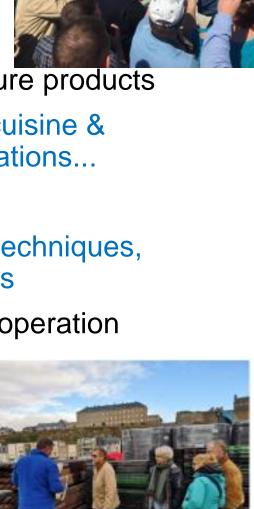




- IT: 5 protected species, promoting local fisheries, EU cooperation (Tunisia)...
- LV: 6 Seaweed assessment plan, fisheries youth camps, smart coastal villages...
- LT: 1 festivals to promote inland fishing
- SI: 1 among 3 inland FLAGs to promote aquaculture products
- **ES: 11** projects, e.g. promoting fisheries heritage, cuisine & tourism; study visits for fishermen, women's associations...
- SE: 1 (7 reported) Seals & Cormorants
- PL: 29 (55 reported), joint learning, e.g. on fishing techniques, study visits etc., joint promotion of fisheries products
- UK: 2 (pending approval) branding/marketing; cooperation among fishermen's associations
