Advances in programming period 2014-2020

In the period 2014-2020 FLAGs can apply for advance payments for planned expenditure for:

- FLAG running costs,

- cooperation.







Advances in programming period 2014-2020

- The basis for advance payment is
- <u>Co-financing agreement</u>, which specifies:
- Time of payment,
- Amount of advance,
- Method of payment,
- ✓ Number of tranches.







Advances in programming period 2014-2020 Advance:

✓ Made to cover <u>future expenses</u>,

- Only for <u>eligible costs</u> of the operation defined in the co-financing agreement,
- ✓ Up to 30 % of the planned costs*

*The beneficiary can apply for a single advance or tranche of any amount, but in this case (s)he has to account for it within 90 days.





Advances in programming period 2014-2020

Advance can be paid if the beneficiary provides some form of <u>guarantee</u>, most often as a secured promissory note with declaration







Advances in programming period 2014-2020 Tranches:

- Before receiving the next tranche the beneficiary proves that (s)he has already spent <u>at least 90 %</u> of the amount received – this is not settlement but just demonstrating that the advance has been spent,
- If the beneficiary receives in total (after this tranche) at least 60% of project amount as advance payment, (s)he must submit the next request for payment within 90 days.
