20% under legal protection 40% protection in inward waters Several marine reserves promoted by fishing sector Only 45km2 NTZ (0.16%)


Tourism dependent economy (50%)

400 different species of fish

Breeding grounds for blue fin tuna
Resident population sperm whales and dolphins

Diverse fishing sector but in decline 35 trawlers - 300 small-scale boats

Catch value 20mill Euro/yr 60,000 recreational fishermen license 23,000 moorings - huge boat density


