

Training topics and target groups

M.A.R.I.N.O. Learning Methodologies and Entrepreneurial Strengthening of New Opportunities

- Providing skill support to new start-ups in FLAG area
- Target mix: long-term unemployed people,
 80 pupils/4 editions 55% men, 45% women



F.O.R.M.A. Training and Orientation for Marine Resources and Aquaculture

Network manager for the Blue Economy

Target 20 pupils (50% unemployed 50% employed, , 40% men, 60% women, secondary school and graduated



Processing of fisheries and aquaculture products

(in partnership with a producer of canned fish)

- Building/repairing fishing gears and nets construction recycle, use of environmentally friendly materials
- R.O.V. operator

Target mix 20 pupils/profile (50% unemployed 50% employed, , 40% men, 60% women



Who chose the training topics: a deep need analysis

A long journey on the coast..

15 meetings in Flag area, one year round

190 stakeholders met

Flag partners, public organizations, local authorities, Coastal Natural Parks and Protected Marine Areas



57 fishermen, aquaculture operators, traders



45 unoccupied people



60 students (last year students secondary school)

Survey tools: focus groups / questionaries /interviews "boat to boat"/ in-depth interviews with key people

Feedback

- Lack of multitask skills/New skills need
- Regional Authority asked us to ensure employability of people involved in training
- People asked quality training
