The importance of time for CLLD


- Local development and community involvement are long-term processes
- Projects take a long time to emerge and develop
- CLLD needs special skills (at community, FLAG, MA, IB level), long to develop and easy to lose

Important to **avoid gaps** between programme periods!



And yet, in previous periods...


Number of FLAGs formally selected

To avoid this...

CPR Art. 32.3 states that:

MAs must "complete the first round of selection of strategies and ensure the local action groups selected can fulfil their tasks (...) within 12 months of the date of the decision approving the programme"

(under multi-funding, within 12 months of the date of the decision approving the last programme concerned).



Thus, you may have to work in parallel on:

FLAG selection

defining budget, no. of FLAGs etc.

preparing FLAG/LDS selection criteria

preparatory support

evaluation & decision

call for FLAGs

 Designing delivery system

> assessing current system

> > discussion with FLAGs & IBs

rules and procedures

IT system, reports, forms...

rules and procedures

may involve

- iterative process with meetings and discussions
- establishing working groups?
- FLAG involvement a key to success! *
- involvement of IBs, Paying Agencies...?
- calculation of SCOs
- taking into account rules on state aid
- training of staff (MA, IB, FLAG...)

* FLAGs are key actors of CLLD delivery; they strongly influence the quality of projects, time of processing, error rates... FLAGs involved in the design and periodic review of delivery more often perceive the system as "helpful" rather than "constraining" (FARNET FLAG Survey 2018/2019)
