## FLAGS SITUATION IN 2014

2 FLAGS :

- ❖ Hisseo : Area 350 000 inhabitants
- ❖ Fecamp : area 40 000 inhabitants

## WHAT MAY BE IN 2021 ?

New geographic criteria to avoid too large areas :

- **Minimum 30 000 inhabitants**
- **Maximum 190 000 inhabitants**
- ❖ 60% cities located on the coast
- ❖ 3 candidates will be selected



3 candidates are expected among these scenarios

# NORMANDY STRATEGY

<b>1- Facilitate promotion of Normandy products to excellence on fisheries</b>	Added value, environment protection, cohabitation between communities
<b>2- Attractivity or skills diversification</b>	Young people involvement, training period, new professional activity, business transfer
<b>3- Promote tourism attractivity and biodiversity</b>	Bring new life in coastal areas, based on Normandy symbols, gathering different communities (fishery and cities), mixing sustainable and responsible tourism
<b>4- Improving circular economy and waste economy</b>	Reduce waste flows at source, good practice, raising local initiatives

	SELECTION CRITERION
STRATEGY QUALITY (40%)	Relevance to Regional strategy included into the application form, Interflags projects, Methodology (SWOT)
LOCAL PARTNERSHIP (30%)	Involvement of public funding for running costs, methodology in partnerships, different meetings, project development skills
FLAG CAPACITY (30%)	Running capacity, financial solidity, monitoring plan, selection process, evaluation and communication, involving in social network, publication

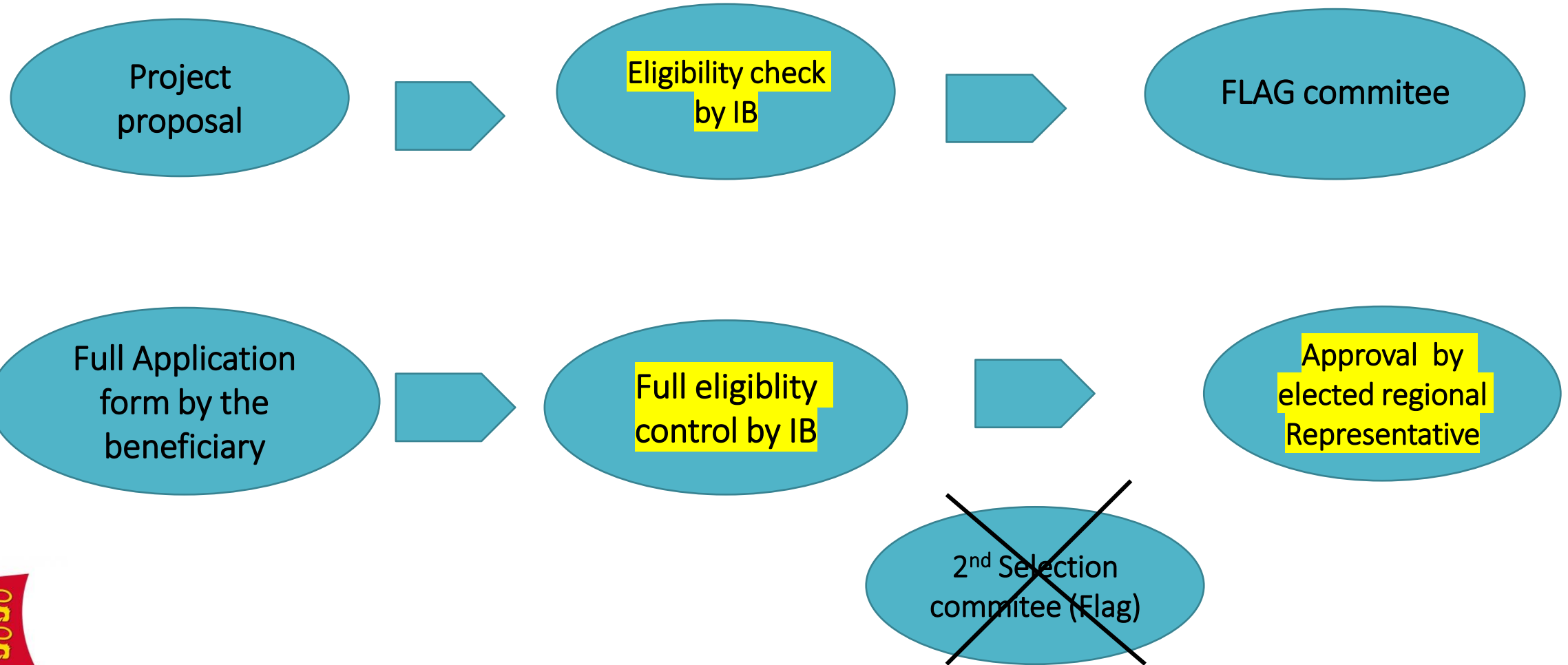

# Simplification

## ❖ SCO

In 2014/2020	In 2021/2027
SCO for indirect costs other than staff costs – 15% (electricity, telecommunications, rent...)  In addition, expenses linked to travel, accommodation, meals etc. – based on real costs verification	A single SCO for <b>all</b> indirect costs other than staff – 25% (electricity, rent, travel, meals etc.)  Developed jointly by national and regional MAs based on real costs in the last 3 years

Simplification and integration of the IT system (entirely paperless)
