Project Transforming Mediterranean SSF

The project promotes stronger cooperation among fishers at the regional level, creating platforms for SSF fishers to unite and exchange ideas and encouraging the replication of co-management schemes and sustainable fisheries practices across the Mediterranean.

Objective 1: Co-management

By July 2022, at **least 9 small-scale fisheries in four Mediterranean countries** (Turkey, Croatia, Italy and Greece) **have developed co-management schemes** leading to sustainable fisheries management.

Objective 2: National SSF Platforma

By July 2022, **50% of fisheries stakeholders** (including cooperatives, fisheries delegates and associations) in Turkey, Croatia, Italy and Greece have **developed** the capacity to **implement sustainable fisheries management**.

Objective 3: Improved Livelihood

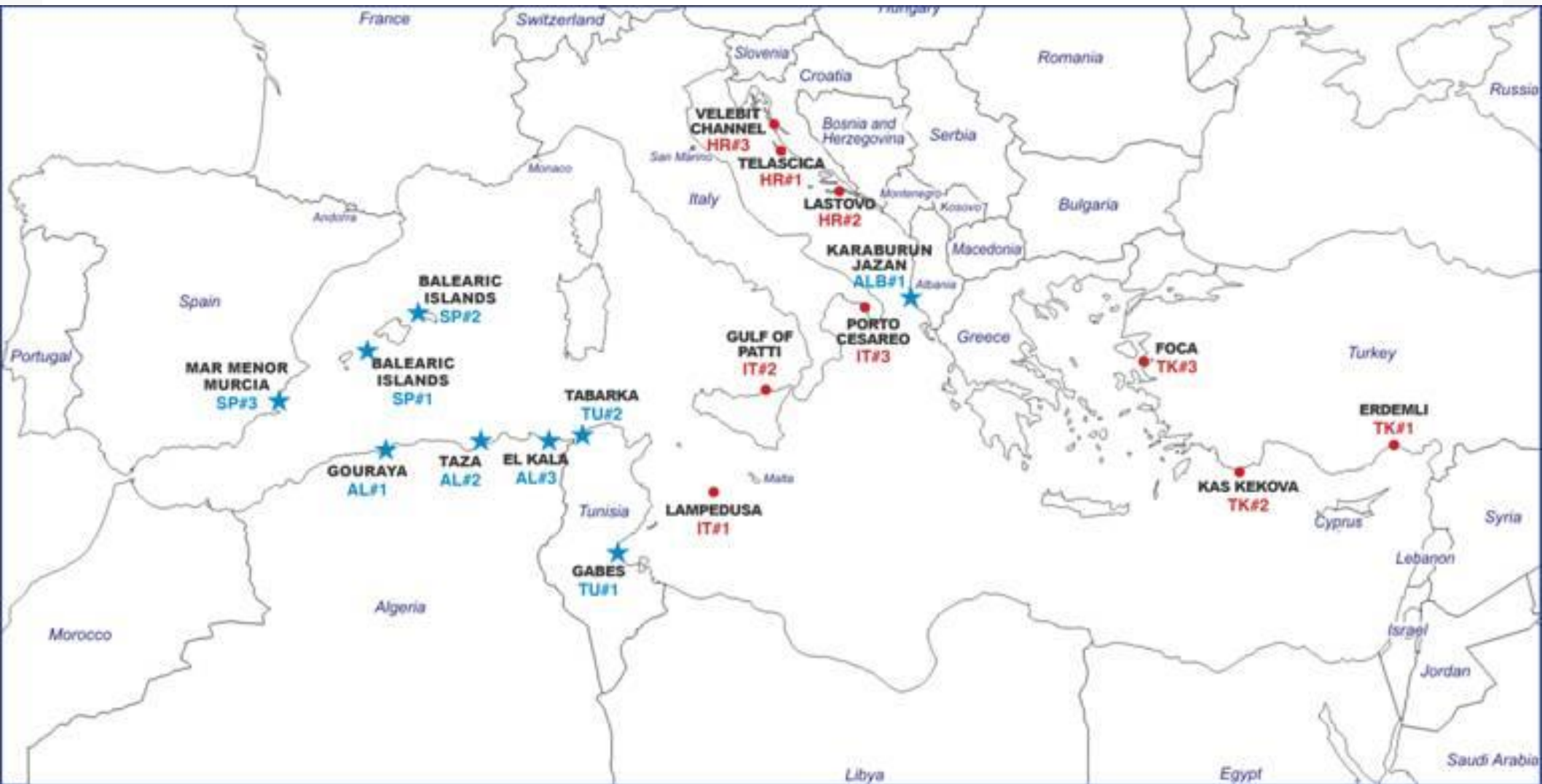
By July 2022, stakeholders from at **least 9 small-scale, sustainably-managed fisheries in four Mediterranean countries** and **improved income and livelihoods**

Objective 4: Knowledge

By July 2022, **knowledge of the status of small-scale fisheries** in the Mediterranean is significantly **improved** and **dialogue** and **networking** among fishers and stakeholders at the Mediterranean regional level is **strengthened**.
